

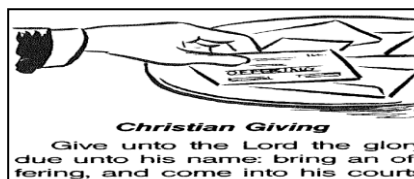

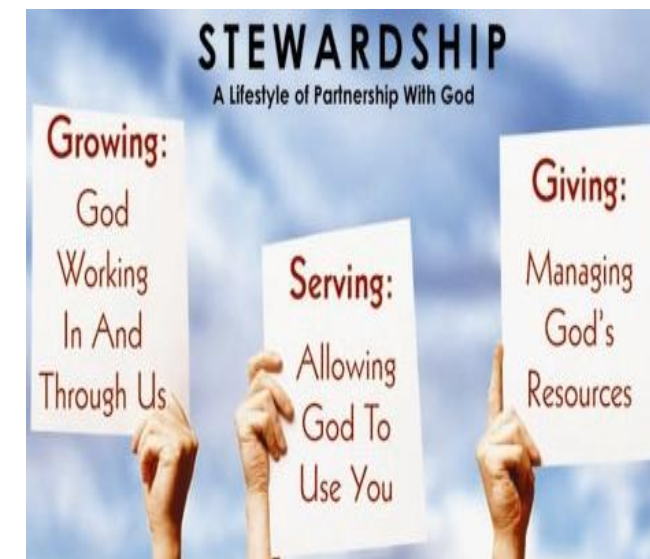

From the Rector's Desk

Christian Stewardship as an act of Thanksgiving

Over the next four Sundays, we shall revisit the concept of Christian Stewardship. Our Stewardship Committee under the joint leadership of Byron Greene and Edith Onyeozili, has decided that there will be four separate addresses delivered, with each underscoring the main theme, that as followers of Christ, we are stewards of the bounty our generous God has bestowed upon our lives. As per usual, we shall be challenged to make formal commitments (sign pledge cards) and these will be offered up before God on Sunday, January 28, 2018.

Appeal for the Kearney Center-Last Wednesday evening, a good representative team from the parish family were on hand to serve the homeless brethren who gathered. Today we issue an appeal for supplies. If you are unable to be part of this ministry, you can assist by making donations of bathroom tissue, socks and toiletries.

Remembrance Project-The parish of St. John has invited us to partner with them for a project that seeks to remember four African American men who were lynched here in Tallahassee between 1897 and 1937. A meeting is to be held on Tuesday, January 16, 2018 at 6:00 pm in their choir room. We encourage your attendance.

Listening Session Planned-On Sunday January 28, 2018, in addition to closing out the stewardship program, the Vestry is asking that we all commit to remaining behind for a brief parish meeting. The liturgy will be adjusted to accommodate all we have planned for that day. The Wardens and Vestry need to hear from each of us as to what we want done here at St. Michael's. Plan to attend.

Rector's Installation- A small committee has been appointed to help make arrangements for the service scheduled for January 31, 2018. Bishop Samuel Johnson Howard will be here along with other Diocesan Clergy. Updates will be provided by the Senior Warden and those serving on the committee.

Change of Date-The Annual General Meeting is now re-scheduled for Sunday, February 18, 2018 and not Sunday 11th as previously indicated. Three members of the present Vestry will be retiring. Do consider placing your name in nomination, so that the parish can begin praying for you.

Confirmation Classes- We are on the verge of announcing the start date for Confirmation Class 2018. If you are desirous of being confirmed, reaffirmed or received into the Episcopal Church, do let us know. Bishop Dorsey Henderson will visit with us sometime after April.
