FROM THE RECTOR'S DESK

The Cursillo Community

Cursillo is a three-day learning, sharing and also inspirational experience of living in a Christian community. The objective of the Cursillo movement is to make Christian community possible in neighborhoods, parishes, work situations and other places where people live the greater part of their lives. Cursillo is patterned on Jesus' own example. He searched out and then called a small group of potential leaders (pre-Cursillo), trained them by word and example, and inspired them with a vision (three-day Weekend), while linking them together, before sending them into the world to bring the world to Him (post Cursillo or the fourth day).

So the Cursillo weekend is not an end in itself. Indeed it is a starting point that goes to the end of one's life. In fact it is a springboard to a long-range practice of the Baptismal Covenant in the life of the Church (the Fourth Day). It will be our privilege to host an Ultreya here at SMAA, the first week of June. Our gatherings are open to anyone who wishes to join our fellowship.
