#### **RECTOR'S DESK**

#### The Feast of Pentecost/Whitsunday

Today we celebrate as a church the feast of the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles fifty (50) days after Easter. This feast day ranks after Easter and is regarded as the second most important festival of the Christian Church's calendar. The liturgical color for today is red and all Sundays between Whitsunday and Advent are described as Sundays after Pentecost, except for next Sunday when we observe as a church, the feast of the Most Holy Trinity.

A quick look back at history will remind us that "Pentecost" was the Greek name given to the Feast of Weeks, so called because it fell on the 50<sup>th</sup> day after Passover. At that feast, the first fruits of the corn harvest were presented as required by Moses in the Law. This explains why there were so many folks in Jerusalem that day when the Spirit came.

#### The Forces of Nature

Thankfully we are able to meet here at SMAA today after seeking spiritual shelter at St. John's last Sunday. We had two visitors from Church Insurance on Wednesday, and one of them remarked to me, "you know this is highly unusual, we expect hurricanes to target the South (in hurricane season) but not tornadoes." Well we had a visitation of three on Friday 10<sup>th</sup>, leaving in their wake a trail of destruction over a twenty (20) minute period, the evidence of which is still among us. I reminded one of our visitors, Carl Kristensen, that climate scientists are now saying that "tornado alley" is drifting southward and we had better pay attention! So last Friday morning was a wake up call for us here in Tallahassee. Yes, in that fateful twenty minute period, homes, vehicles, businesses and our three university centers, all suffered damage of some magnitude. Many of us were spared, but others were not so fortunate and had to wait days for the power supply to be restored (some are still waiting I hear). Hopefully telephone and internet services will become more stable as the days go by. I have heard stories of food items that had to be dumped (Grace Mission reported), and yet here we are thanking our God that we survived the worst. Our God kept Tally during that horrific span of twenty minutes and brought us safely through! While we will never be able to control the Forces of Nature, we know that we serve a God who has promised to keep us safe in the midst of every storm that threatens our lives.
