The Assisting Bishop of the Diocese the Rt. Rev. Scott Benhase will visit with us here at St. Michael & All Angels on September 29, 2024. Roof Repairs Begin

After almost three months of anxious waiting on negotiations between Church Insurance and contractors, and praying for reprieve from thunderstorms, more tornadoes and hurricanes, the work to repair St. Michael facilities began on Thursday, August 8th. Initial assessment of the damage to our parish hall roof suggests we will need additional funds, thousands more that the funds on hand from our insurance settlement and generous contributions/donations. The St. Michael parish family thanks our friends for the support we have already received and additional support that is promised. We are blessed.
