

- (i) A souvenir booklet is to be published in time for the celebration—will include paid ads, messages etc. Marie Roberts will oversee its publication.
- (II) On Wednesday (Sept 24th) an evening of fun will be hosted by the committee (comedy and other forms of entertainment will be provided).

- (vii) Bishop 'Chip' Stokes will be the celebrant and preacher for the occasion. As a reminder, all those wishing to be reaffirmed or received into the Episcopal Church, must let the rector know.
- (viii) A comprehensive clean up of the parish grounds is to be done in time for the celebration.
- (ix) A letter of invitation is to be sent to all Episcopal Churches in the Apalachee Region.
