Social Worker at Grace Mission

Our sister church of Grace Mission is seeking to employ a full time social worker. Such an individual will cost Grace \$80,000 a year (salary & benefits). Grace Mission is the face of the Apalachee Region, providing assistance to our brothers and sisters on the streets. Indeed, Mtr. Rachel and her team offer to those who visit, Help, Healing and Hope. In addition to spiritual counsel, weekly Bible Studies and a hot meal are provided at least twice a week. Grace also provides those on the street with the opportunity to take a shower as well as help with the acquisition of ID's. Assistance is provided to those applying for jobs, and food stamps/Social Security benefits. In a word, Grace Mission offers the "gospel in action." In order to procure the services of a social worker, Grace needs 66 persons to pledge \$100 monthly. Want to support this ministry? Let us hear from you.
