FROM THE RECTOR'S DESK

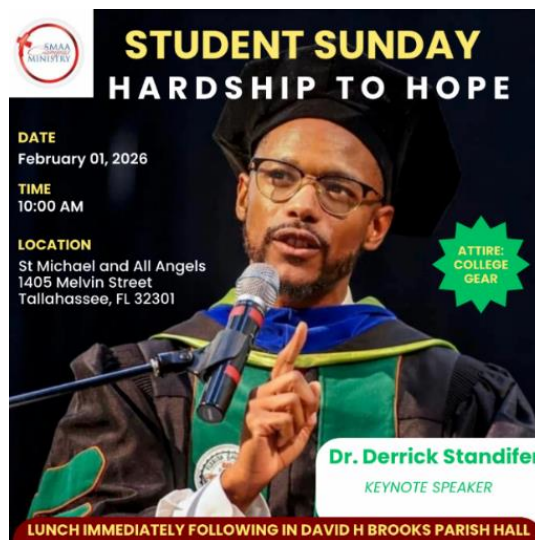
Special Welcome

As a student at Florida A&M University, his path did not begin with success. He dropped out, faced setbacks, and had to confront what it truly meant to start over.

Through faith, discipline, and persistence, he returned to complete his bachelor's degree, went on to earn his master's degree, and ultimately his PhD, all while raising his children as a full-time single dad of two.

Through his platform, *Life Is Like a Rubik's Cube*, Dr. Standifer teaches students and families how to navigate confusion, endure challenge, and finish hard things with purpose and integrity. His message reminds us that failure is not final, and we can redeem any journey when we stay obedient to the process.

Just recently, Dr. Standifer was selected as one of the honorees for an Excellence Educational Leadership Award. Each year Black male educators across Georgia, are nominated for their contribution in the field of Education by their peers and community leaders.
