

The Bishop Search Committee has released the profile they have prepared for the would be applicants. The parish office has made the full text of the document available, which includes the Nomination Form (deadline included—March 9, 2026), and the Application Form (deadline—March 23, 2026). As a diocese, we need to remain in prayer so that the Lord will send us a true and faithful shepherd. This is truly an exciting time for us as a Diocese as we claim the Spirit's guidance and pray for the new leadership our Diocese is seeking. The Book of Common Prayer helps us understand the sacredness of the task that lies ahead of us and why we need to commend all those who will put their names forward for consideration. The date for the Election is -September 11, 2026, while the date of ordination and consecration is set for February 6, 2027.
